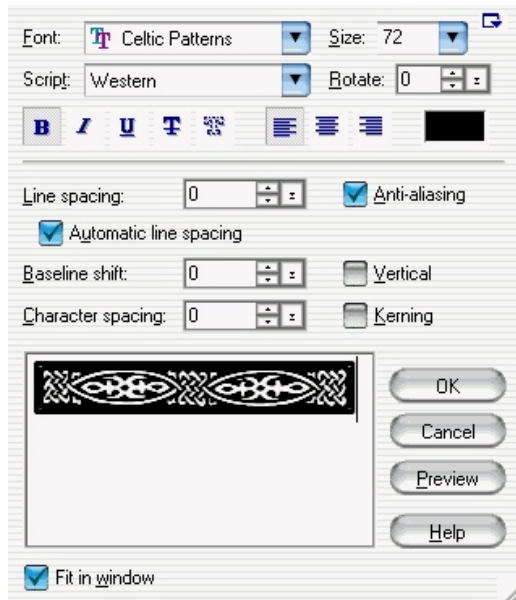
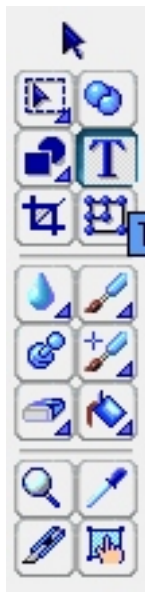


# Quick Celtic Frame

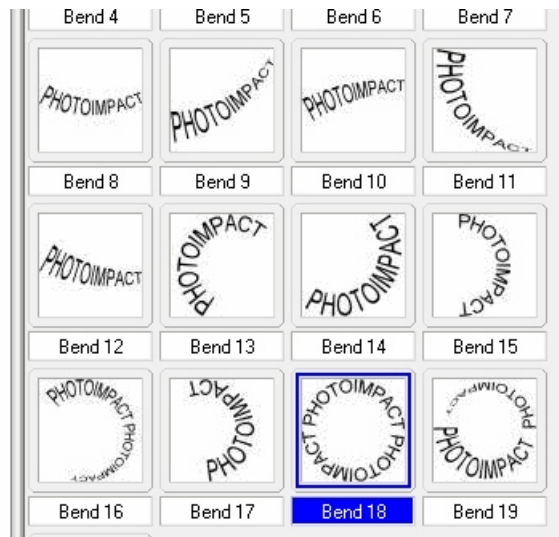

**Skill Level:** Easy

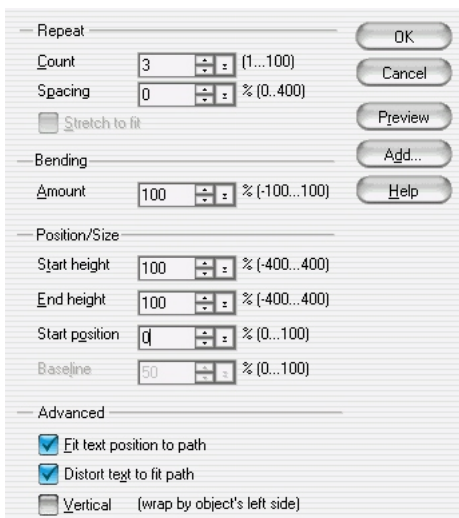
**Materials needed:** PI 7 &  
Celtic Patterns Font



Create a new image, about 640 X 480. Then select the text tool and choose the Celtic Patterns font. Pick size 72 and Type in the "J".



Bring up your Easy Palette. Select Bend Text from Wrap Gallery. Then choose Bend 18. Right click and select **Modify Properties and Apply**.



Choose the following settings: **Repeat:** Count 3, Spacing - 0, **Position/Size:** Start position - 0. Leave everything else as is.



There you have a round frame that you can use for whatever you like. Now check out the **Material attribute Gallery** (**Metallic** is a good one).



Here's the frame with **Copper 10** preset applied. Choose different presets to find one you like. You can turn it into an object and further edit the object to cover up the lines in between each section to make it look continuous.
